The Retired Faculty Association of UNC Chapel Hill wants you to know...

about the following benefits for retirees:



Health Insurance: Retirees who have five years of State Membership Service in the Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System (TSERS) or are vested in the Optional Retirement Program (ORP), may be eligible to continue to receive retiree health insurance through the State Health Plan, as long as they are receiving a monthly retirement benefit from a TSERS or ORP account.

UNC Personal Identification Number (PID): Retirees must initiate a request to keep an active PID as a University affiliate. Affiliate status must be renewed every 10 years.



UNC One Card: Retirees can get a new UNC One Card, giving them continued access to e-mail, the libraries (including e-resources from off-campus), employee discount programs, and campus recreation. You must first be activated as a University affiliate.

On-Line Campus Directory: Retirees may choose to continue to be listed in the on-line directory.



Parking: Retirees may be able to obtain a parking permit, depending on availability from their last employing department.

Emeriti Faculty: Retirees may continue to use the professorial titles and distinctions that they held immediately prior to retirement with the courtesy designation "Emeritus" or "Emerita" appended.



Business Cards: Emeriti faculty may request University business cards to be printed to reflect their Emeritus/Emerita title and current contact information.

Retired Faculty Association (RFA) Membership: The RFA is a voluntary, dues supported professional association of retired faculty members and others who have joined together to maintain ties to the University and to promote their common interests. \$25 a year for annual dues; \$150 for a lifetime membership.
